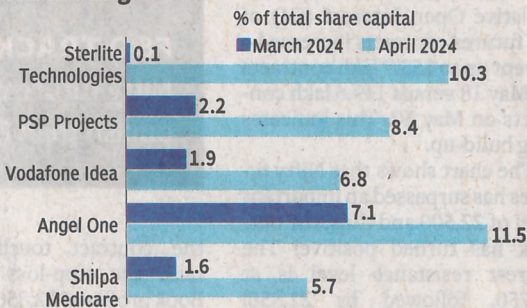




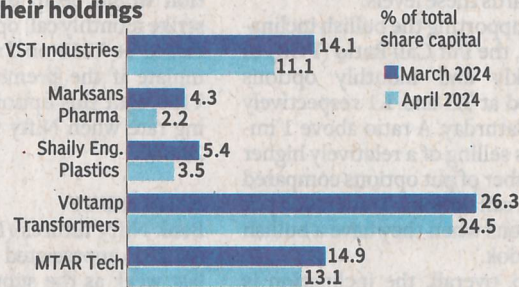
MF shareholding trends

Prime Mutual Funds Database has released its monthly tracker of mutual funds for April. Fund houses made notable new stock entries by subscribing to the initial public offerings (IPOs) of companies such as Bharti Hexacom and JNK India. On the other hand, there were complete withdrawals from stocks such as Brightcom Group. NSE has suspended trading of Brightcom shares starting June 14, 2024. Top 5 companies where MFs have increased their holdings

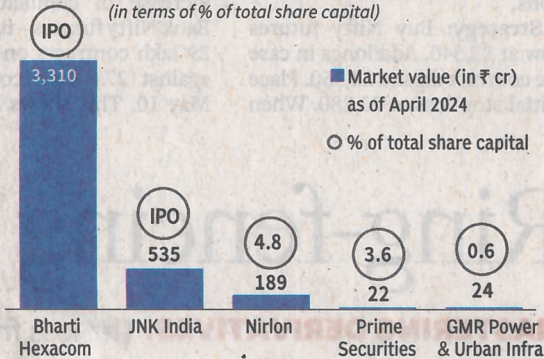


Top 5 companies where MFs have decreased their holdings



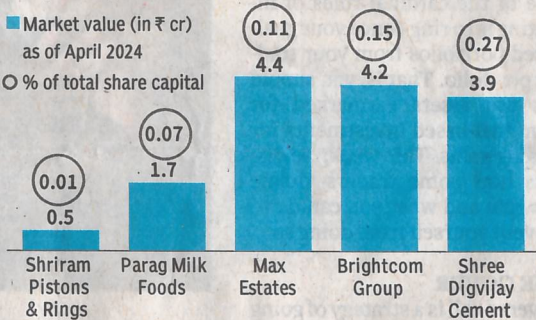
Top 5 new stock entries of fund houses

(in terms of % of total share capital)



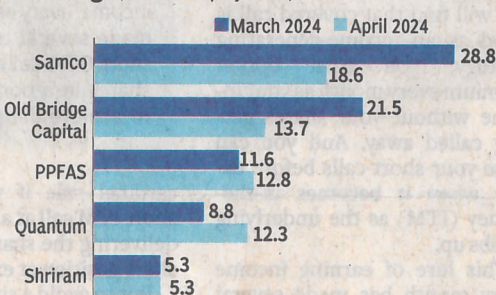
Top 5 stocks which mutual funds have completely exited
